## From the Principal

After a very quick turnaround we are back to onsite learning. A huge thank you to our whole school community for your wonderful support and understanding. Also, thank you to our amazing staff who enacted a very quick plan to offer remote and flexible take home learning packs for all of our students by the end of the day!



We are all hoping to have a much more settled routine between now and the end of the term. In the meantime the following is the **most current school based COVID safe update:**

- Parents and carers must wear a face mask when in indoor settings including schools, early childhood education centers and places of study, unless an exception applies. It is recommended parents and carers wear face masks outdoors where physical distancing cannot be maintained, for example at a congested school drop off or pick up.
- Visits to the school **that exceed 15 minutes must be registered with the office.** Please ensure that your drop offs and end of day collections are quick, as we simply do not have the capacity to register parent catch ups in the playground. 😊
- We need to maintain a **2sqm space per person**, this includes teachers and students. For this reason we can **only accommodate 1 extra adult in any classroom space at any given time.** If you are waiting to speak to a staff member, please remain outside of the classroom and wait for another parent to depart the classroom.
- To greater support the flow of students and families at the beginning and end of each day, we are **developing entry and exit protocols** for each grade and cohort level. More details soon.
- **School staff do not need to wear masks when teaching or caring**, but are welcome to wear a mask at any time.
- **Personal hygiene is critical.** Students have access to both soap and hand sanitiser and are supported by regular hand washing routines throughout the day. We also have a cleaning regime during and at the end of each day.
- **If your child is unwell** in the morning, please keep them at home. One day of rest can make a big difference to your child's learning and also helps to keep other students and staff well. **If a staff member needs to have a COVID test, they are out of the school for 3+ days.** While we can't stop everyone from getting sick, we would like to lessen the impact where we can. When teachers are absent, we call in relief teachers and there is no guarantee that we can access the same staff on consecutive days.
- We are in the process of reinstalling some of our outdoor drinking taps. **Students will still need to bring along a refillable drink bottle daily.**
- **We can accommodate limited visitors onsite daily.** Please make an appointment via the office (56 72 1600) should you need to make an appointment.
- **Parent, Student, Teacher Conferences can go ahead as planned.** Families meeting onsite on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> February (Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> are phone conferences) do not need to sign in, your conference booking will cover your time onsite.

## **IN SPORT**

### **Water Safety Program**

Our Water Safety Program is in full swing. Students are learning about

- Decision making in and around water
- Stroke development
- Water Safety

**The pool is salt chlorinated** (the water doesn't irritate the students skin or eyes) and is solar heated to between 24 - 30 degrees. Perfect swimming conditions!

**Please ensure student clothing is clearly labelled** with your child's name as we often have 200+ students swimming in the pool each day making it easy for clothing to be misplaced.

The Water Safety program is part of our school curriculum as mandated by the Education Department. Our school has a culture of 'have a go' and it's so pleasing to see students getting out of their comfort zone and learning new skills in an aquatic setting.

### **Wetsuits and flippers**

Our school is always appreciative of any wetsuits or flippers that families are willing to donate to the school. They are used in our pool swimming program, various beach days and in water activities on school camps to further enhance our Water Safety Program.

### **District Swimming**

**On Friday 19th February**, 24 WPS students participated in the District Swimming Carnival held at Cowes Primary School. The students represented their school with distinction and should be proud of their efforts and behaviour. They took great enjoyment in fine tuning their swimming skills in the lead up to the event.

The most important part of our Water Safety Program is ensuring that EVERY student in our school has the necessary skills to be safe in and around the water. Of course we are always going to want to be faster and more successful in swimming competitions but the aim of our swimming program is not solely based on winning ribbons.

**Poppy M** was our Swimming Captain and showed great leadership and responsibility to her peers. Poppy and Archie J competed in the Championship races and performed well.

**Congratulations to Boyd M** who has qualified for the next stage of competition - Division Swimming – to be held at Korumburra 50m Pool this Friday 26<sup>th</sup> February.

## FROM THE OFFICE

### **IS YOUR CHILD FEELING UNWELL?**



If your child is displaying ANY of the following symptoms we ask you to please keep them at home and consult your doctor. **Runny nose, stuffy nose, sore throat, headache, cough, shortness of breath, fever, chills or sweats, fatigue, muscle soreness, nausea, vomiting and diarrhoea or loss of sense of smell.** If your child attends with any of these symptoms we will call to ask you to have them collected. Please make sure you mark an attendance note on Compass or alternatively call the school to advise the office.

### **Compass**

If you do not have a Compass login yet, need help with using Compass or do not know what it is, simply contact the office and we can assist.

**Need to pay fees, buy a school bag or hat for your child?** No Problem!! Contact the office to pay over the phone with credit card or to transfer into the school account. The friendly office team are happy to help. Organising things over the phone with the office ladies is much more convenient and safer.

**For any assistance at all** don't hesitate to contact the ladies in the office who are happy to help in any way they can.

## MEDICATION AT SCHOOL

Sometimes your child may need to take medication at school, for example, antibiotics, Ventolin, creams for rashes etc.

All medication, creams, lotions, sprays that your child may require to take at school must come via the office. This medication will need to be accompanied by a Medication Approval Form filled out and signed by you, the Parent/Guardian.

or a copy can be obtained from the office.

All medications and other lotions and spray must be kept in our school sick bay. Therefore you should also send a note to your teacher or place a note in your child's student diary explaining that your child is on a new, existing or ongoing medication. Then the teacher is aware they may have to send your child over to the sick bay during the day to have this medication given or applied.

If you have any concerns or need further clarification, don't hesitate to call the lovely ladies in the office.



### **HEALTHY EATING**

**Fruit break is a very important part of the day, so please send your child with fruit and veg each and every day.**

## ROAD AND BIKE SAFETY

We would like to remind everyone of the Importance of Road Safety especially around School Zones.

For the safety of our children please make sure that you **obey speed limits and park within designated parking areas.**


**Double parking when dropping off and picking up children is illegal and very dangerous not only for your child but for others in the Community.**
