Financial Support for Families

Wonthaggi Primary School understands that some families may experience financial difficulty and offers a range of support options, including:

- Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund (CSEF)
- Centrepay

Camps Sports & Excursions Fund (CSEF) is available for eligible families. Those who received it in 2023 and are still eligible will automatically have their 2024 application processed. An application form is attached for new applications (for newly eligible families or students new to the school).

Payment methods

We offer a range of payment methods to assist our families:

- Direct Deposit bank account details are available by calling the office.
- Centrepay instalments for families who receive Centrelink benefits an application form is attached.
- Cash/Cheque please hand directly to an office staff member who will issue you with a receipt. Do not send cash with your child.
- Compass Pay parent payment are set up on CompassPay and parents can nominate amounts they wish to pay for voluntary payments. For user pays costs, the amount is set.

FREE INSTRUCTION

- Schools provide students with free instruction and ensure students have free access to all items, activities and services that are used by the school to fulfil the standard curriculum requirements in Victorian Curriculum F-10, VCE and VCAL.
- Schools may invite parents to make a financial contribution to support the school.

PARENT PAYMENT REQUESTS

Schools can request contributions from parents under three categories:



Curriculum Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for curriculum items and activities which the school deems necessary for students to learn the Curriculum.

Other Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for non-curriculum items and activities that relate to the school's functions and objectives.

Extra-Curricular Items and Activities

Items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are above and beyond what the school provides for free to deliver the Curriculum. These are provided on a user-pays basis.

• Schools may also invite parents to supply or purchase educational items to use and own (e.g. textbooks, stationery, digital devices).



FINANCIAL HELP FOR FAMILIES

- Schools put in place financial hardship arrangements to support families who cannot pay for items or activities so that their child doesn't miss out.
- Schools have a nominated parent payment contact person(s) that parents can have a confidential discussion with regarding financial hardship arrangements.



SCHOOL PROCESSES
